Nominations must be postmarked by June 1st of the year to the CMEA President who acts as the Committee Chairperson. Individuals may initiate the nomination, but group participation and system-wide involvement in the nomination is encouraged.

Qualifications:

Nominees should be exceptionally supportive of arts education and demonstrate over time a commitment to furthering the growth of music education. This individual’s (organization’s) personal attitude and philosophy show a dedication to support program development and improvement as well as understands unique program requirements including but not limited to program resources, community support, and financial support. This individual or organization provides leadership in areas of advocacy by being a voice in the music education community.

Nomination applications: In addition to this form, the application should include:

- Biographical information
- Nominator letter of support addressing career accomplishments and contributions to music education
- Additional letters of support (at least two)
- Photograph suitable for printing (300 dpi)

It may also include:

Photographs; news clippings; letters of endorsement and/or narrative descriptions from area educators, parents, students, volunteers or community leaders; of the nominee’s specific support, unique leadership, and creative contribution in the area of music education. These are not required, however will add to the credibility of the nomination.
