Advertising Refund Policy

All advertising requires a completed advertising contract. All fees paid are non-refundable when placing your contract and advertising reservation.

All-State Events Refund Policy

(Elementary, Middle, and High School All-State Choir, All-State High School Jazz Choir, All-State High School Orchestra)

All-State event audition fees No Refunds shall be issued

All-State participation fees No Refunds shall be issued

All double payments will be assessed a 25% refund processing fee.

CMEA Conference Refund Policy

Cancellations/Refunds:

No **cancellation refund for conference registrations** will be provided within 2 weeks of the conference start date. ... If cancellation occurs prior to 2 weeks before the conference, a 50% administrative fee will be assessed to all refund requests.

All **cancellation** requests must be submitted via email to officecmeaonline@gmail.com.

Membership payments when registering for the conference are non-refundable and all parameters of the CMEA membership policy apply.

No **cancellation refunds for exhibitor registrations** will be provided. All sales of exhibitor fees are final at the time of purchase beginning on July 1, 2020, and moving forward.

No refunds will be granted for registrations to virtual content. If you are unable to view any purchased content during the scheduled times, all events in the conference will be recorded and available for replay after the event concludes.
