Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

CMEA President Cynthia Eversole emailed all board members a description of the issue requiring a special board meeting and called for a vote via Google Forms.

All members of the Board of Directors completed the Google form.

Discussion Item

The current vocal music representative for District 4 on the CMEA State Assembly, Mr. Brooke Mead, engaged in deceptive and unethical behavior while representing his district as a representative of the CMEA State Assembly. Based on this behavior, the recommendation of the Colorado High School Activities Association, and the CMEA Executive Board, it is recommended that Mr. Mead be removed from his position on the CMEA State Assembly immediately. Furthermore, Mr. Meade will be placed on probation for two years. He will not be allowed to supervise his students without a member of the school administration present at any All-State High School Choir Event for two years, commencing on January 15, 2024, and running through January 15, 2026.

The decision to remove Mr. Mead and place him on probation with restrictions was unanimously approved by the CMEA Board of Directors through an online via Google Documents.
